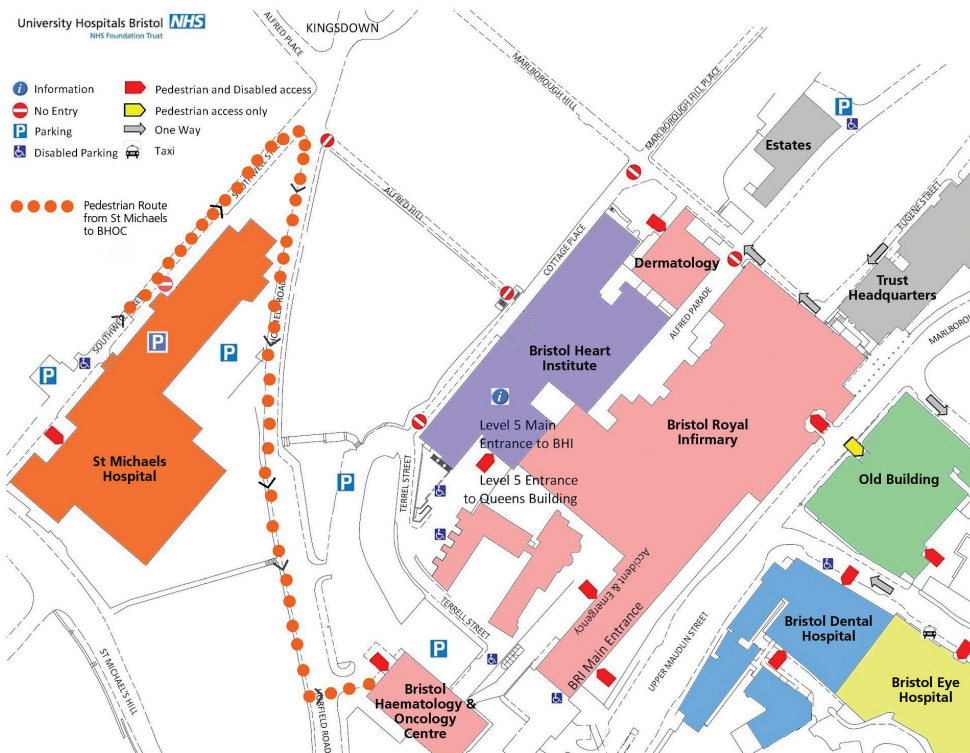

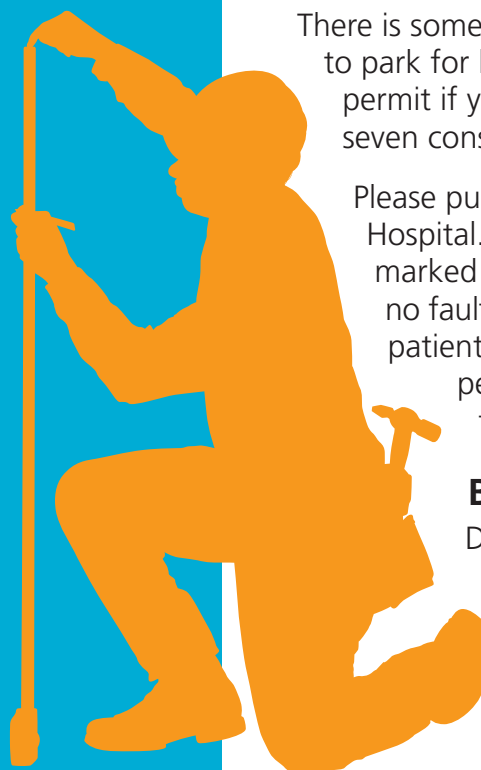

**It's all change for the better at the Bristol Royal Infirmary. We've wanted to move beds out of the Old Building and the King Edward building for ages, and now we are. It's going to take time, as we need to build a new ward block to take the beds, but it will definitely be worth the wait.**

But, it does mean a lot of disruption for a while. So please, allow longer to park and think about other ways of getting to BHOC for your appointment.

### **Car parking at Cabot Circus**

The car park at Cabot Circus offers rates of £1.50 for the first hour and then £1 per hour (for the following six hours). There's a free return shuttle bus, funded by our charity Above & Beyond to the BHOC and our other hospitals. The bus runs every 15 minutes, Monday to Friday (8am-4pm) and every 20 minutes (7am-8am) and (4pm-8pm).

### **Patients receiving oncology or haematology treatment**

There are only a few long-stay parking spaces at BHOC for patients who need to park for more than two hours; if someone is dropping you off, please ask them to drop you off and park in the St Michael's car park, a short walk away (see map). There's a shuttle bus back every 30 minutes to St Michael's from the main entrance following your treatment, or they could get the car and come and pick you up. There are two drop-off spaces right next to the main entrance.

### **Patients receiving radiotherapy treatment, or outpatients**

There is some short-stay parking at BHOC for patients who need to park for less than two hours and you can get a BHOC parking permit if you're having regular treatment. The permit is valid for seven consecutive days and costs £3.

Please purchase a ticket as normal and park at St Michael's Hospital. If you do park at BHOC, please park in one of the marked short-stay bays. Sometimes you may be delayed through no fault of your own, so please pick up and display a BHOC patient card from main reception along with your parking permit so that the parking attendant knows you are on treatment and will not issue you with a fine.

### **Blue badge holders**

Disabled badge holders can park in any of our car parks free of charge. Please park in the long stay parking area near to the BHOC main entrance and display your badge clearly. Do not park in the ambulance bays, or those marked for emergency consultant teams or you will be issued with a fine.
