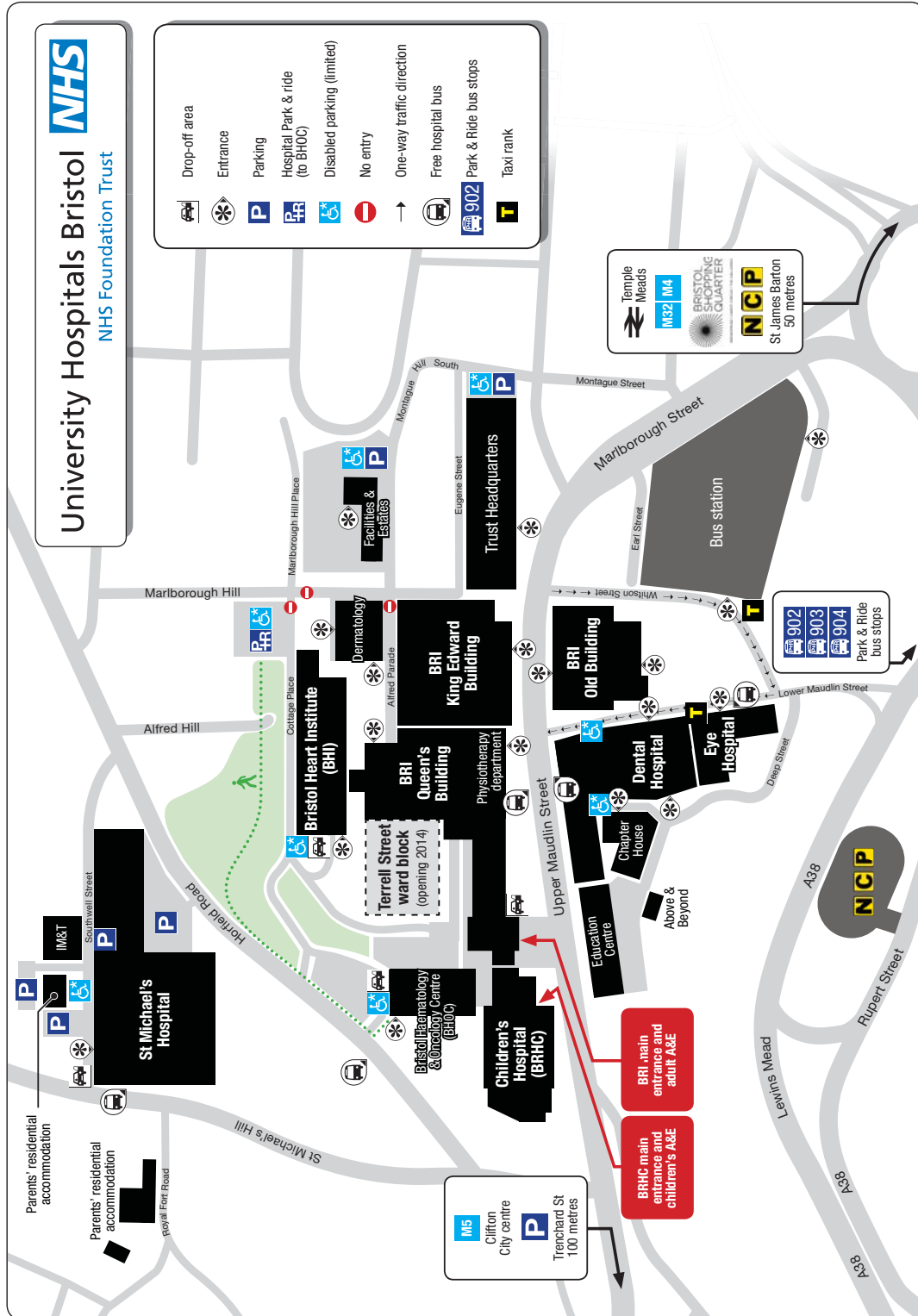

BUILDING A BETTER BRISTOL

We are making a lot of improvements across our hospitals which will affect your visit to the Bristol Royal Hospital for Children, including where you can park and be dropped off. Please read this information carefully before you come to see us.

Building our future... at Bristol Royal Hospital for Children

Bristol Royal Hospital for Children is being extended to allow the children's services currently provided at Frenchay Hospital to be transferred in 2014. It's a really exciting time because all specialist children's services will soon be provided from a single, state-of-the-art children's hospital in the centre of Bristol.

But it does mean there will be some disruption and noise. So please allow extra time for parking and dropping off and think about other ways to get to the children's hospital for your appointment or admission.

Bringing patients to hospital

If you are bringing your child to the hospital, please consider whether you can be dropped off and collected, or can use public transport to help with congestion. The hospital is a short walk from Bristol Bus Station and a free bus service operates to and from Bristol Temple Meads train station, Monday to Friday. The bus stop is to the right as you come out of the station. Patients can be dropped off at the main entrance, but should not park in the drop-off area or in the ambulance bays.

Where can I park?

Parking is very limited on our site and we want to prioritise what is available to people with mobility issues, or people with emergencies. You are welcome to use any of the Trust's pay and display car parks or any of the public car parks situated close to our hospitals (see map overleaf). The car park at Cabot Circus offers rates of £1.50 for the first hour and then £1 per hour for the following six hours. We run a free return shuttle bus from Cabot Circus to our hospitals. The bus runs every 15 minutes, Monday to Friday (8am to 4pm) and every 20 minutes (7am to 8am and 4pm to 5pm). The bus leaves from outside the ground floor car park exit next to Shopmobility.

Patients attending for longer stays

If your child is staying in hospital for two days or more, you can get a parking permit from the main reception which will entitle you to reduced rate parking in the Trust's pay and display car parks. Please ask the staff at the reception desk for further details.

What if I have a Blue Badge?

If you are a Blue Badge holder you will be able to park free of charge in any of the Trust's pay and display car parks. Please do not park in the drop-off areas, such as the area in front of the Bristol Royal Infirmary, or you will risk a fine.
