Referral information	<p>Emergency / Urgent appointments can be made with Consultants in Oral Medicine for the following conditions:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trigeminal neuralgia • Suspected cancer – intractable oral ulceration, premalignant lesions • Debilitating oral ulceration • Immuno-compromised patients • Loss of oro-facial sensation <p>Urgent appointments maybe discussed prior to referral by ringing the Primary Dental care Unit on 0117 342 4375/76</p> <p>Indications for referral for consultation for non-urgent patients are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oro-facial pain, other than trigeminal neuralgia • Burning mouth syndrome • Chronic disorders of the mucous membrane • Benign swellings, including those of the salivary glands • Lesions of the oral mucosa (ulcers, white patches, red patches, swellings) • Persistent cervical lymphadenopathy • Facial pain that a GDP has not been able to diagnose or control • Salivary gland disorders (swellings, dry mouth) • Trigeminal neuralgia • Oral dysaesthesia (sore/burning mouth) • TMJ dysfunction <p>Please note – patients with suspected cancer must be referred via the Fast Track Office:</p> <p>0117 342 3266</p> <p>TMJ Pain referrals</p> <p>Should be made on the attached TMJ pain referral proforma.
