

1. Please could you inform me of the number of dialysis patients you have undertaking the following treatments at your hospital renal units, and the company who's equipment they are using:

Number using Baxter equipment	5 on Gambro Baxter machine (1 patient occasionally uses a Fresenius machine)	0	11

2. Also the average cost of waste dialysis bags and waste drain lines per patient per year for the above automated peritoneal dialysis patients.

We do not hold this information as this service is outsourced. Our contract includes a monthly service charge inclusive of waste dialysis bags and waste drain lines
