Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trusts response is as follows:

1) How many vacancies in your trust are currently unfilled (as of today when you compile the answers to this FOI)?

As at 28th February 2017, there were 332.6 FTE vacancies at University Hospitals Bristol NHS Foundation Trust.

- 2) How many of those unfilled vacancies are for nursing jobs? 165.3 FTE
- 3) How many of those unfilled vacancies are for consultant jobs? 7.5 FTE
- 4) How many of those unfilled vacancies are for roles within your ICU (if applicable)?

There are 0.13 FTE vacancies for consultants in ICU (including paediatric ICU and neonatal ICU). For nursing, there is currently an over-establishment of 3.6 FTE.

5) How many of those unfilled vacancies were first advertised over 6 months ago (first posted in October 2016 or before)?

We do not hold this information

6) What is the longest duration any of your current vacancies has remained unfilled?

We do not hold this information.
