Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trusts response is as follows:

1. What does the Trust use for securing resus trolleys? For example, is a tamper evident seal used, or a lock and key?

A tamper evident seal is used to secure the resus trolleys.

2. How many are used by the Trust annually? In 2016/17, 7600 were purchased by the Trust.

3. What is the Trust's annual spending on these? In 2016/17, the Trust spent £1,464.52 on seals.

4. Where does the Trust order these from?

The trust orders the seals through EROS from Distinctive Medical.

5. Who is responsible for ordering this product?

The individual wards and departments order the seals.
