The 'Prolift' device is not used in this Trust therefore we do not hold this information.

2) Please provide the costs of purchasing the "Prolift" in each of those years requested in question 1.

We are unable to provide the costs as the the 'Prolift' device is not used in this Trust; therefore we do not hold this information.

3) Please provide how many times the "Prolift," has been used as a device to treat pelvic organ prolapse in your NHS Trust in each of the following years: 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 (in either calendar or financial, however this information is held)?

We are unable to provide the requested breakdown of usage as the the 'Prolift' device is not used in this Trust.

I have received information that the Trust previously used 'Advantage TVT slings' to treat pelvic organ prolapse in the Heygroves Theatres until around 4 years ago when the service moved to Southmead Hosptial. These were also used in the Trust's Gaeneocology department until late last year and they now use Boston product MOO68505110 Halo Obtryx 11. I have also received confirmation that neither of these products are the 'Prolift' product; therefore we have been unable to answer your request as we do not hold the requested information.
