Please confirm information regarding International recruitment services (Nurse, AHP, and Doctors) from 01/04/16 - 01/04/17. What did the Trust spend on recruiting Permanent staff (Nurses, Doctors and AHP/HSS) from:

- **The UK and EU**
- **International (such as India, Philippines)**

The Trust has not undertaken any specific recruitment overseas either international or EU. Therefore the cost of recruitment can only be expressed in terms of the Trust's advertising costs for the year which was £337,000 and covers all recruitment e.g. clinical and non-clinical and was UK based although anything advertised online is worldwide.
