Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trusts response is as follows:

I've read that Bristol Eye Hospital will now be known as Zone H. Has this change been subject to an accessibility and equalities review?

Please note the hospital is still referred to as Bristol Eye Hospital on correspondence to patients and on the front entrance signage.

No separate specific accessibility and equalities review was carried out however the signage strategy brief (which was commissioned from a third party signage consultancy company) included guidance on signage suitability for the wider community, including the partially sighted.

2) If you've done accessibility and equalities review, I'd like to see a copy. This is not available as there was no specific accessibility and equalities review carried out however we can provide a copy of the 2013 Trust-wide Signage Strategy Document, should you require it.
