Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trusts response is as follows:

Your RTT data shows an unexpected excess of Completed Admitted and Non Admitted Pathways at Over 52 Weeks during the month, versus the number of Incomplete Pathways which are likely to go over 52 weeks at the beginning of the month. The table below shows the list of trusts showing the same excess in the May 2017 RTT data.

The attached spreadsheet shows the history of this for University Hospitals Bristol since 2010, where IP = Incomplete Pathways, CAUP = Completed Admitted Unadjusted Pathways and CNAP = Completed Non Admitted Pathways. The data is shown in the chart below, which shows the excess of Completed Pathways since mid 2015.

Please explain why University Hospitals Bristol reports an excess of Completed Admitted and Non Admitted Pathways at Over 52 Weeks during the month, versus the number of Incomplete Pathways which are likely to go over 52 weeks at the beginning of the month.

Please be advised the Ongoing data is correct. The Clock Stop data over states the 52+ week position due to validation issues. Please note that the Clock Stop itself is correct, it is the overall RTT wait time that is not always validated.
