I refer to a freedom of information response sent to my colleague Paul Heaney on 20.1.17, Ref: UHB 16-329. In that response you disclosed a list of response times from the Specialist Paediatric Transport Service in relation to calls / referrals from Wales for the three months from the beginning of October 2016 to the end of December 2016.

In the response spreadsheet you gave call date, referring hospital, call decision, mobilisation time and transit time. I would like the same information covering the period 1.1.17 to now.

Please find the Trust's response in the attached document. Please note the data in the attached refers to a seven month period, from 01/01/2017 to 31/07/2017.
