

2. If you have the information, please can you detail the kind of injury sustained eg. head injury or spinal injury.

We do hold the requested information however as there are low numbers for each type of injury we are unable to disclose this information. We have considered that there is the potential for the individuals to be identified, when considered with other information that may be in the public domain. In our view disclosure of information would breach the Data Protection Act. Therefore please find that Section 40 (2) exemption contained within the Freedom of Information Act 2000 is engaged. Section 40 is the exemption for personal information.
