Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- Does a specific venous thromboembolism protocol exist for your Trust
 If so:
 - a. What date was this protocol put into place Yes the Trust has a guideline protocol for Deep Vein Thrombosis (DVT), Pulmonary Embolism 2019 and VTE prevention policy 2018. Please see attached.
 - b. When is it due for review?
 2022. Please note that policies may be reviewed before the review data if it is necessary (new developments /new guidelines).
- 2. Is there a preferred Direct Oral Anticoagulant (DOAC) or are all utilised within the trust for VTE

They are Rivaroxaban or Apixaban as these are initiated as oral only regimes which facilitates early ambulatory management.

- 3. How many patients have been treated for VTE with a DOAC in the last 12 months 1.907.
- 4. What volume of each DOAC was used to Treat in this same time period Apixaban=5,591.

Dabigatran=357.

Edoxaban=362.

Rivaroxaban=5,071.
