I have reviewed the data that your Trust submitted on the number of Type 2 attendances (Type 2 A&E department = A consultant led single specialty accident and emergency service (e.g. ophthalmology, dental) with designated accommodation for the reception of patients) that you had in December 2019 via the below website:

Of the 1935 type 2 patients seen in December 2019 please can you advise of the numerical split across each specialty (Ophthalmology, Gynaecology) etc?

There is only one Type 2 Emergency Department in the Trust.

This is the Bristol Eye Hospital. All of the Type 2 attendances seen in December 2019 are in Ophthalmology.
