Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- Do you insource any clinical services and which ones? Surgery Division insource endoscopy services. Specialised Services Division insources Cardiology. Women's & Children's: Insources Gynaecology outpatient activity, paediatric cardiology outpatient activity, paediatric spinal surgery outpatient and inpatient activity and paediatric urology inpatient activity.
- Do you have a contract with any company and who is that and for which insourcing services?
  Surgery Division and Sp. Services Division: The Trust currently has an overarching contract with Glanso and is working to put a tender in place to establish a city wide framework contract.
  W&C: As above.
- 3. Did you procure this under any current framework and if so which one? Please see response of question 2.
- 4. How is this charged for by the third party service provider per patient/per tariff. Surgery Division: This is charged at tariff minus a percentage that varies by service. Specialised Services: This is charge per patient. W&C: For all services with the exception of paediatric spinal surgery, the charge is the same as described by Surgery Division. For paediatric spinal surgery, a standard sessional fee applies.
- Are you currently being charged below, on or above NHS tariff? Below NHS tariff. W&C: Below NHS tariff (see Q4).

6. Do you use substantively employed Trust staff to deliver all or part of the insourced service?

Surgery Division: Yes.

Specialised Services Division: Glanso paid staff are employed for the work. W&C: Glanso paid staff are employed for the work. The clinicians who provide the service are generally substantively employed by the Trust.
