Dear Sir/Madam

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

1. How many radiotherapy treatment sessions were rescheduled due to the linear accelerator(linac) they were due to be treated in being out of service for repairs or maintenance.

Patients' treatment sessions are rescheduled for a number of reasons, such as clinical, personal, etc. not only because of Linac downtime. Our systems record when patients have been treated but not when their appointments have been changed or why. The Trust has around 38,000 attendances for radiotherapy every year. To identify each sessions that was rescheduled due to Linac downtime the Trust would have to manually check each patient record and this would take the Trust more than 18 hours to complete and it is therefore exempt from disclosure under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

If, after that, you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
