Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

Request:

Could you please supply me with details of the failure rates of gastric banding
undertaken by the by band sleep study at Bristol University Hospital. I would specifically
like the percentage of patients who failed to achieve the desired outcomes of having a
gastric band fitted not the bypass of the sleeve.
I understand this was a nationwide trial, but I understand that the study was carried out
by Bristol University. Therefore, my request is made to you.

Response:

Gastric banding is undertaken by the T3 Management System at North Bristol NHS Trust. University Hospitals Bristol NHS Foundation Trust sees patients referred to them to determine if OSA is present and then write back to them with the results and the patient being on or off CPAP.

Therefore, UHBristol would suggest that this is redirected to the T3 group at NBT.
