Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

1. What is the average waiting time in weeks from referral to an initial appointment with the pain management service?

4 weeks

2. What is the average waiting time in weeks from referral to commencing treatment, ie, RTT time?

6 weeks.

3. Does your pain management service involve a multidisciplinary team (including medical consultants, nurses, physiotherapists, psychologists, pharmacists) as recommended by the Faculty of Pain Management's core standards for pain management services in the UK?
