Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- Which manufacturer (PBX or VOIP) are you using as your core telephone system? e.g. Avaya, BT, Cisco, Mitel, Skype for Business? Cisco and Siemens DX.
- Approximately how many extensions does the system support across your organisation? Cisco: 2500. Siemens DX: 2500.
- Who is the incumbent/support partner for the maintenance of your VOIP/PBX? Cisco Block Solutions. Siemens DX Tele Response.
- 4. How many of those extensions are contact centre/customer service agents? 80.
- When does your PBX/VOIP support contract expire? Cisco: July 2020. Tele Response: March 2023.
