Dear Sir/Madam

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

1. Do you offer a recruitment package for Cardiac Physiologists? If yes what?

The Trust does not offer a standard relocation package for recruitment but will review on a case-by-case basis. The maximum the Division has confirmed that it would consider to offer is £2500.

2. Do you offer a retention package for Cardiac Physiologist? If yes what?

For retention, the Trust offers an additional one off payment for additional on call shifts worked. This would only apply to staff that cover gaps in on call rota outside of a frequency of 5 sessions per month.

A weeknight 12 Hour period accounts for 1 session and a weekend 24 hour Period accounts for 2 sessions.

Shift	Additional one off payment for the on call shift (on top of payment for hours worked)
Night on call (12 hours)	£40
Weekend (24 hours)	£80
