Dear Sir/Madam

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

1. My enquiry is what point of care test is used in your trust to measure troponin in patients with suspected acute coronary syndrome?

The Trust does not do point of care testing in the Emergency Department. Patients requiring a TnT will have a sample obtained by venepuncture sent to the lab for analysis.

2. Primarily whether you use a point of care test in A+E and what point of care test is used, such as if it is a high sensitivity troponin or one of the earlier point of care assays.

Our lab TnT is high sensitivity TnT, Elecsys.

This concludes our response. We trust that you find this helpful, but please do not hesitate to contact us directly if we can be of any further assistance.
