Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

Request:

- 1. In the last three years, have any cases of women being admitted because they took abortion pills ordered online been recorded by staff at the hospitals looked after by your trust?
- 2. If so, how many?

Response:

University Hospitals Bristol NHS Foundation Trust does not code this in its systems and therefore it is unable to answer this request.

However, the Trust has also checked with the midwifery managers and there has not been any record of abortions due to abortion pills.
